Applicants must submit an audition DVD or CD (DVD is preferred). Identify your disk by writing your name, age, instrument and the works performed on the label. Recordings will not be returned.

Audition recording repertoire requirements are as follows:

Violin – Concerto movement (e.g. Bach a minor, Mozart G Major), 2) additional piece (applicant's choice) of comparable technical difficulty.

Viola - Concerto movement (e.g. Telemann, Seitz, Stamitz), 2) additional piece (applicant's choice) of comparable technical difficulty.

Cello – Sonata movement (e.g. Eccles g minor, Sammartini G Major 2) additional contrasting piece of applicant's choice (e.g. Bach Suite in G Major)

Piano – Sonata movement (e.g. Mozart, Beethoven), additional contrasting piece of applicant's choice (e.g. Chopin, Schumann, Liszt)

A \$25.00 non-refundable fee must be included with this application. All application materials must be received (postmarked) by April 1, 2009. Send to: The Hartt School Community Division; University of Hartford; 200 Bloomfield Avenue; West Hartford, CT 06117

Notification of acceptance will be sent by May 1, 2009. Make checks payable to: University of Hartford.
